IMPORTANCE OF MARKING YOUR BALL ON THE GREEN



Once you're on the green there are a few things to remember. First mark your ball IMMEDIATELY, before any player is ready to putt. USGA Rule 11.1a and 11.1b state: If a player's ball in motion after a stroke on the putting green hits another ball at rest on the putting green, the player who made the stroke incurs a two-stroke penalty in stroke play. Both balls must be on the green. In match play, there is no penalty-the ball is played as it lies. (Most of the regular play days for the HGWGA are stroke play, regular golf.) This rule does not apply to a stroke taken from off the green that may hit a ball on the green. If the ball is not marked before it is your turn to putt, then you should ask the other player to please mark their ball.
