RINGERS & AWARDS

Here are some reminders about Ringers, both a tracking mechanism for individual improvement and qualification for the Ringers tournament (a minimum of 6 rounds (Wednesday or tournament):

- I encourage all members to refer to the Ringer Guidelines, an excellent description of how the Ringers system works for our league; including criteria for the end of year tournament and payouts for awards for most improved, birdies, eagles, and Hole-in-ones.
- This season we will post our scores in the GGID app during our round along with the written score cards which need to be turned into the Pro Shop. Both will provide the scores for Ringer's spreadsheet.
- Do not forget to hang your birdies cards (or better) on the tree in the locker room. These are collected to recognize individual achievement and a chance to win a gift card at our opening and end of year tournaments!!
